



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE No. 2024/091

Review of Measures No. 652 in relation to Deep Drawn Stainless Steel Sinks

Exported from the People's Republic of China

Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

The Acting¹ Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has extended the due date to publish the final report and recommendation to the Minister about the above case.²

The Commissioner is not inviting further submissions by granting this extension.

New milestone dates

Final Report – A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a final report which is now due on, or before, **04 December 2024**.

A statement of essential facts was published on 17 October 2024. The previous due date for the final report was 27 November 2024.

Basis for extension

I, Justin Wickes, am the Acting Deputy Commissioner Investigations, Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission). I requested the extension of the due date to provide the final report and recommendation to the Minister.

I requested the extension because of the complexity of matters raised in submissions and because the commission has recently received late submissions which the Commissioner has decided to have regard to.
