Subject: Request for Reconsideration of SYS Submission Regarding Ad Valorem Measure

To the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC),

We, SYS [SIAM YAMATO STEEL], refer to the Statement of Essential Facts No. 642 and note that our submission has yet to be considered. In this regard, we respectfully request that the ADC consider our submission dated 28 October 2024, which pertains to our request for reconsideration of the imposition of an Ad Valorem measure.

SYS would like to highlight the current situation with Liberty Steel, which is unable to supply products to the market, potentially causing a shortage. Given these exceptional circumstances, we believe the ADC should reconsider its position, considering the potential market disruption due to this supply issue.

Additionally, SYS would like to emphasize that it has never had the intention to engage in predatory pricing or cause material injury to domestic prices. This assertion is corroborated by the fact that SYS has supplied products solely to Southern Steel. This fact further demonstrates that SYS has no intention of harming competition or distorting pricing in the market.

In light of these points, SYS believes that the imposition of an Ad Valorem measure would be a sufficient and appropriate remedy in this matter.
