



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2025/007

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

Aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from People's Republic of China

Termination of Accelerated Review 661

Xiamen Hopergy Photovoltaic Technology Co., Ltd

Background

On 9 December 2024, Xiamen Hopergy Photovoltaic Technology Co., Ltd (**Xiamen**) lodged an application with the Anti-Dumping Commission (**commission**) for an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain aluminium extrusions exported by Hopergy to Australia from the People's Republic of China.

On 12 December 2024, the commission confirmed receipt of Xiamen's application for an accelerated review and provided an exporter questionnaire to Xiamen in relation to the accelerated review, with a due date for completion of 20 January 2025.

On 17 December 2024, Xiamen requested an extension to provide its response to the questionnaire.

On 24 December 2024, the Acting Deputy Commissioner¹ of the Anti-Dumping Commission rejected the extension request on the basis that it will likely prevent the timely completion of the case within the prescribed statutory timeframe.

Grounds for termination

The legislative framework that underpins the making of, and the consideration of, an application for accelerated review of dumping duty and countervailing duty notices is in Divisions 1 and 6 of Part XVB of the *Customs Act 1901* (Cth) (**the Act**).

On 20 January 2025, Xiamen requested the commission to terminate the application for the current accelerated review.

Following that notification, I, David Latina, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, am satisfied that the accelerated review may be terminated in

accordance with section 269ZE(3)(a) of the Act. I have therefore terminated the review.

Termination of this accelerated review does not prevent Xiamen from applying again for an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain aluminium extrusions exported by Xiamen to Australia from the People's Republic of China.
