# **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2026/040**

## **Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel**

### **Exported from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

#### **Assessment of corporate restructure**

### **China Steel Sumikin Vietnam Joint Stock Company**

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) has received an assessment form on behalf of the China Steel and Nippon Steel Vietnam Joint Stock Company (CSVC) from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) to examine whether CSVC is effectively the same entity as an exporter previously examined and currently listed in the Dumping Commodity Register (DCR) exporter table.<sup>1</sup>

CSVC has advised the commission that it recently changed its registered and/or trading name and has provided information seeking to confirm its status as the previously examined exporter China Steel Sumikin Vietnam Joint Stock Company.

The commission may allow an entity which has undergone a corporate restructure or registered/trading name change to replace a previously examined exporter on the DCR if the commission considers that the new entity is in essence the same as the previously examined exporter. The effect of this amendment to the DCR is that exports by the new entity are subject to the dumping and/or countervailing measures applying to the previously examined exporter.

#### **The current assessment**

The commission received the completed form on 2 February 2026. The request by CSVC concerns the following anti-dumping measures that were in place on imports at the time of the publication of this notice. Details of the relevant commodity, exporter and dumping specification number are outlined below.<sup>2</sup>

According to the commission's records, CSVC was previously examined in Continuation Inquiry 592.<sup>3</sup>

If the commission considers that CSVC is effectively the same entity as China Steel Sumikin Vietnam Joint Stock Company examined in Continuation 592 and listed in the DCR, the commission may replace China Steel Sumikin Vietnam Joint Stock Company with China Steel And Nippon Steel Vietnam Joint Stock Company in the DCR.

In making its assessment, the commission will consider:

- information contained in the form
- further information requested from interested parties and
- timely submissions received by the commission.<sup>4</sup>

The commission will aim to complete its assessment within three months.

### **Public record**

There is no legislative requirement to maintain a public record for this assessment. However, in the interests of transparency, a public record will be maintained. This notice, along with any non-confidential submissions that are received, will be published on the electronic public record (EPR), available at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au).

### **Lodgment of Submissions**

Interested parties are invited to lodge written submissions concerning this assessment no later than the close of business on 24 April 2026, being **14 days** after publication of this notice.
