## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2026/048**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

**Chrome-plated steel bar**

**Exported from Romania**

### **Findings of the Continuation Inquiry No 686 into Anti-Dumping Measures**

*Public Notice under section 269ZHG(1) of the Customs Act 1901*

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has completed an inquiry, which commenced on 30 September 2025, into whether the continuation of the anti-dumping measures in the form of a dumping duty notice applying to chrome-plated steel bar exported to Australia from Romania is justified.

Recommendations resulting from that inquiry, reasons for the recommendations, and material findings of fact and law in relation to the inquiry are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 686* (REP 686).

I, TIM AYRES, the Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science, have considered Report 686 and have decided to accept the recommendation and reasons for the recommendation, including all the material findings of facts and law therein and have decided that the anti-dumping measures applying to chrome-plated steel bar exported to Australia from Romania should continue from 8 September 2026.

Under subsection 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I **declare** that I have decided to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures currently applying to chrome-plated steel bar exported to Australia from Romania.

I **determine** that pursuant to subsection 269ZHG(4)(a)(i) of the Act, the notice continues in force after 7 September 2026 (the specified expiry day).

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel ([www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au)), in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
