PVC Flat Electrical Cables

**Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China
by Dongguan Minxing Cables Co., Ltd**

**Findings in Relation to Review of
Anti-Dumping Measures No 684**

***Notice under section 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901 and
Notice under section 8(5) and section 10(3B) of the
Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975***

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has completed a review, which commenced on 8 July 2025, of the anti-dumping measures applying to PVC Flat Electrical Cables (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China) by Dongguan Minxing Cables Co., Ltd (Dongguan Minxing).

The Commissioner's recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No.684* (REP 684).

I, TIM AYRES, Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science, have considered REP 684 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 684.

Under section 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act), with effect from the date of publication of this notice, the dumping duty notice and the countervailing duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from China by Dongguan Minxing is to be taken to have effect as if different variable factors had been fixed relevant to the determination of duty.

In accordance with sections 8(5) and 8(5BB) of the Dumping Duty Act, and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Regulation 2013* (the Regulation), I determine that the interim dumping duty (IDD) is an amount worked out in accordance with the floor price duty method pursuant to sections 5(4) and (5) of the Regulation.

In accordance with section 10(3B) of the Dumping Duty Act, I direct that the interim countervailing duty (ICD) be ascertained as a proportion of the export price of the goods exported to Australia from China by Dongguan Minxing (i.e. an ad valorem method).

Pursuant to section 8(5BA) and section 10(3D) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of specifying a method such that the sum of:

- a. the export price of the goods of that kind as so ascertained or last ascertained.
- b. the ICD payable; and
- c. the IDD payable on the goods;

does not exceed the non-injurious price (NIP) of goods of that kind as ascertained for the purpose of the notices in respect of the goods exported from China.

Particulars of the dumping margin, subsidy margin, the IDD, the fixed interim countervailing duty (ICD), and duty methods are set out in the following table.

Exporter	Dumping margin	Subsidy margin	Fixed IDD and duty method ¹	ICD and duty method
Dongguan Minxing	2.5%	1.2%	NA – floor price duty method	0% - ad valorem
