



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2026/088

Zinc coated (galvanised) steel

Exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Withdrawal of application for a dumping duty notice Investigation No. 703

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 22 May 2026, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) published Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2026/071¹ announcing the initiation of an investigation (Investigation 703) into the alleged dumping of zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea) by Dongkuk Steel Mill Co Ltd (DSM), Dongkuk Coated Metal Co. Ltd (DCM) and Posco Holdings Inc (POSCO), and from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) by Hoa Sen Group Joint Stock Company (Hoa Sen) and Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company (Nam Kim).

The investigation followed an application by BlueScope Steel Ltd (BlueScope).²

On 18 June 2026, by notice in writing lodged with me as Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, BlueScope withdrew its application for Investigation 703, in accordance with section 269TB(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*. Accordingly, I have ceased Investigation 703 concerning the application and no findings will be made on the allegations of dumping, material injury and causal link.
