Investigation No. 691 – Aluminium Windows and Doors from China

Australian aluminium windows and doors manufactures submissions in support of the investigation and measures

As you are aware from previous submissions by Capral Limited (**Capral**) in respect of Investigation No 691, Capral welcomes and fully supports this investigation and the imposition of anti-dumping and countervailing measures on aluminium windows and doors (**AWDs**) exported from China.

Capral considers that dumped and subsidised imports of AWDs from China adversely affect Australian AWD manufacturers and the broader domestic aluminium supply chain. Capral supports effective measures to restore fair competition and protect Australia's domestic manufacturing capability.

Capral encloses letters from customers and participants in the Australian AWD industry. The letters support the investigation and the imposition of anti-dumping and countervailing measures. They also provide information concerning material injury experienced as a result of dumped AWDs imported from China.

The enclosed letters are submitted on a **Commercial-in-Confidence** basis. The letters are confidential because they include Capral customer details and other commercially sensitive information, including information about business size, capacity and financials, as well as claims relating to injury and causation. They are also confidential to protect the businesses concerned from possible adverse commercial consequences arising from public disclosure of their participation in the investigation.

Capral trusts that the enclosed letters will assist the Commission in its assessment of material injury to the Australian industry and the measures to be imposed in Investigation No. 691.
