Aluminium extrusions Exported from Malaysia by PMB Aluminium Sdn Bhd

Revision of review period and issuance of new questionnaires

Customs Act 1901 (Cth) - Part XVB

Revised review period

On 19 June 2026, I, David Latina, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission), published a notice announcing that Review 667 had resumed following a period of suspension.¹ In this notice, I also invited interested parties to lodge submissions concerning the review, including the resumption of the review.

I have decided to revise the review period for Review 667. In doing so, I have considered the length of time this review was suspended and had regard to submissions made in response to the resumption notice I published on 19 June 2026.

The revised review period for Review 667 is **1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026**. The original review period for this case was 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025. I selected this period because it is the most recent 12-month period for which stakeholders' complete financial records are available. I understand that financial records for the April to June 2026 quarter may not yet be finalised.

New questionnaires issued

I have issued new questionnaires for the revised period. The commission sent these questionnaires to stakeholders in Review 667 who had previously provided questionnaire responses for this case or in recent related cases.²

The commission sent new questionnaires to:

- the applicant and importer, Press Metal Aluminium (Australia) Pty Ltd
- the exporter, PMB Aluminium Sdn Bhd
- the Australian industry members:
 - Capral Ltd
 - Extrusions Australia Pty Ltd
 - G James Australia Pty Ltd
 - Independent Extrusions Pty Ltd (known commercially as INEX Australia).

The commission requested that the stakeholders respond to the questionnaires:

- for the applicant and importer by:
 - 29 July for part A,
 - 14 August for parts B and C, and
 - 21 August for parts D and E.
- for the exporter by 28 August 2026
- for Australian industry members by 6 August 2026.
