



Dumping and Subsidy Investigation 691

Aluminum Windows and Doors

Exported from the People's Republic of China

File note

The Anti-Dumping commission (the commission) received a submission in response to the initiation of Investigation 691 from the China Chamber of Commerce of Metals, Minerals & Chemicals Importers & Exporters (CCC MC) in relation to the commission's assessment of the application lodged by Ventora Group Pty Ltd (Ventora) & Australian Glass and Window Association (AGWA) and the initiation of the investigation.¹

In particular, the CCC MC submits that the commission has not disclosed in *Anti-Dumping Commission Consideration Report No. 691* (CON 691)² the industry members that supported the application. CCC MC submits it is not clear that the application was supported by a sufficient part of the Australian Industry.

The commission is publishing this file note to detail the Australian industry members that supported Ventora and the AGWA's joint application.³ At the time of CON 691, the commission assessed the supporting statements of these manufacturers including the reported production volumes which were contained in confidential attachments to the application.⁴ For an application to be supported by a sufficient part of the Australian industry, the Commissioner must be satisfied that members of the industry (including the applicant) who support the application must account for more than 50% of the total production of industry members who have expressed either support for, or opposition to, the application; and they must account for not less than 25% of the total Australian production.⁵ The total production volume reported by the members listed below and the applicant Ventora represents 55% of the total estimated production volume of like goods.
