



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2026/114

Certain Steel Corner Beads and Angles Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China Wenan Jinkai Building Material Co., Ltd Termination of Accelerated Review No 704

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

1. Introduction

I, David Latina, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner), on 4 June 2026, notified interested parties that I had commenced an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain steel corner beads and angles (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China), in so far as they relate to a new exporter, Wenan Jinkai Building Material Co., Ltd (the applicant).

2. Grounds for termination

On 5 August 2026, the applicant notified the Commission in writing that it requested the withdrawal of its application for an accelerated review. Following that notification, I am satisfied that the accelerated review may be terminated in accordance with section 269ZE(3)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901*. I have, therefore, terminated the review.

3. Effect of the termination of the accelerated review

Termination of this accelerated review means that any securities required and taken in relation to the goods exported by the applicant and entered for home consumption from 21 May 2026 will now be converted to interim dumping duty. The applicable rate of duty is the 'all other exporters' rate of interim dumping duty applicable to China.
