ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2026/133

REINVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FINDINGS IN RELATION TO INVESTIGATION 654 CONCERNING TOMATOES, PREPARED OR PRESERVED EXPORTED FROM THE ITALIAN REPUBLIC

On 4 June 2026, the commission published Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No 2026/074, advising interested parties that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) had requested the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) to reinvestigate certain findings in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 654*.

The commission further advised that it would publish a Preliminary Reinvestigation Report (PRR) on its electronic public record and invite interested parties to make submissions in response to the Commissioner's preliminary findings.

The commission proposes to publish the PRR on 28 September 2026. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions in response to the Commissioner's preliminary findings within 14 days of that publication date. Any submissions received within this period will be taken into account in preparing the reinvestigation report to be provided by the Commissioner to the ADRP.

On 15 September 2026, the ADRP granted the commission a 21-day extension to provide the reinvestigation report to the ADRP. The reinvestigation report is now due to be provided to the ADRP by 6 November 2026.
