Republic of Korea by Dongkuk Coated Metal Co. Ltd,
Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd and POSCO, and from
the Socialist Republic of Vietnam by Hoa Sen Group and
Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company**

Termination of part of Investigation No 706

Public notice under section 269TDA(15) of the Customs Act 1901

On 19 June, 2026, I, David Latina, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea) by Dongkuk Coated Metal Co. Ltd, Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd and POSCO, and from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) by Hoa Sen Group and Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company, following an application lodged by BlueScope Steel Limited under section 269TB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act).

At this stage of the investigation, I am satisfied that Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd did not export the goods during the investigation period (1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025), and therefore there has been no dumping of the goods by Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd. I have therefore terminated part of the dumping investigation in accordance with section 269TDA(1)(b)(i) of the Act as it relates to Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd.

The investigation into the alleged dumping of the goods from Korea by Dongkuk Coated Metal Co. Ltd and POSCO, and from the Vietnam by Hoa Sen Group and Nam Kim Steel

Joint Stock Company, will continue. I am due to publish a statement of essential facts in respect of this investigation on or by 7 October 2026.

BlueScope Steel Limited may request a review of this decision to terminate the investigation by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel in the approved form and manner within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
