Subject: Dumping Margin and Subsidy Margin for Hengshui Jinghua Steel Pipe Co.,Ltd.

in Statement of Essential Facts No. 177

Dear sir or madam.

With regards to the Statement of Essential Facts No. 177 which announces a dumping margin of 28.1% and subsidy margin of 5.0% of Hengshui Jinghua Steel Pipe Co.,Ltd,("Hengshui Jinghua"), the following arguments are hereby raised on behalf of Hengshui Jinghua.

- Hengshui Jinghua is not affected by any governments' actions which are identified
 as special market situation listed in the Statement of Essential Facts. The verification
 team visiting Hengshui Jinghua also did not find any such government actions which
 constitute a special market situation in Hengshui Jinghua's production, operation or
 exportation. In fact, Hengshui Jinghua operated and exported under a complete
 market conditions.
- An uplift of as .benchmark price for raw materials of HSS, i.e. hot rolled coils does not have adequate basis and factual ground.
- 3. The hot rolled coils' prices of private-owned suppliers of Hengshui Jinghua shall not be lifted up because privately owned suppliers did not receive any benefits from governments or public bodies, neither affected by governments or public bodies.



4. Subsidy Program 20 is double with the constructed domestic value which includes an uplift of hot rolled coils. 5.0% of subsidy margin arising from Program 20 is repeated calculation with 28.1% of dumping margin which is based on a constructed domestic value including a constructed hot rolled coils price.

In sum, we strongly oppose the dumping margin and subsidy margin levied for Hengshui Jinghua in the Statements of Essential Facts. Customs Service shall adopt minus 2% of dumping margin and no subsidy margin determined in Hengshui Jinghua's verification report.
