



## **REVIEW INTO MEASURES APPLICABLE TO ALUMINIUM ROAD WHEELS EXPORTED FROM CHINA**

### **NOTE FOR FILE - RECORD OF MEETING WITH REPRESENTATIVES FOR GOVERNMENT OF CHINA**

#### **Background**

On 22 June 2015 the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) met with representatives from Moulis Legal, acting on behalf of the Government of China, to discuss the Commission's review into measures applicable to aluminium road wheels exported from China.

#### **Matters discussed**

- Moulis Legal raised various issues on behalf of the Government of China which Moulis Legal viewed should be considered as part of the market situation analysis for this review, including:
  - China's status as a market economy;
  - Trends towards increasing competition in the Chinese aluminium and aluminium road wheels sectors;
  - The differences between the aluminium and aluminium alloy market; and
  - Findings by the former Trade Measures Review Officer and World Trade Organisation Disputes Settlement Body in relation to public bodies.
- Moulis Legal advised it would follow up the meeting with a formal submission which provides further detail regarding Government of China concerns in relation to the aluminium road wheels review.
