The Malaysian exporter [REDACTED] is prepared to offer a price undertaking in accordance with s 269 TEB(1) on its future exports to Australia which during the investigation period comprised two categories of the HSS generic group, namely:-

- [REDACTED] CHS for supply to a local [REDACTED] equipment manufacturer, [REDACTED], being the majority of its exports and,
- In Line galvanised product.

The [REDACTED] CHS for [REDACTED] equipment did not enter the commercial, competitive market for HSS and on my reading of the applicants submission and the ACBPS visit report, it would appear that these imports caused no concern, let alone any price affects to the applicant Onesteel-ATM.

Given that the [REDACTED] CHS is sold to an end user manufacturer it is considered appropriate that these goods be treated separately as a specific sub set of the HSS goods under consideration.

Kindly consider recommending to the Minister that if the [REDACTED] CHS exports of [REDACTED] are not excluded from the GUC, then a price undertaking be applied to future [REDACTED] exports of the [REDACTED] CHS.
