Anti-Dumping Investigation 384 - Alloy round bar exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Dear Mr Piper,

Liberty OneSteel provides the following evidence in direct response to the Commission's request for information contained in the file note dated 4 September 2018:

- Toll rolling arrangements currently operating between Moly-Cop and Liberty OneSteel.
 - The terms and conditions of the current toll rolling arrangements between Liberty OneSteel and Moly-Cop are evidenced partly in writing and partly expressed through the course of conduct and dealings between the parties.
 - Insofar as the agreement is expressed in writing, it is contained in CONFIDENTIAL ATTACHMENT 1: Terms document setting out the intended toll manufacturing terms and conditions between parties ie. OneSteel Manufacturing (Liberty OneSteel) and Commonwealth Steel Company (Moly-Cop)
 - Insofar as the agreement is expressed in the course of dealings and conduct between the parties, Liberty OneSteel provides CONFIDENTIAL ATTACHMENT 2: Evidence of course of conduct supporting the acceptance of the intended toll manufacturing terms and conditions between the parties, supported by a contemporaneous transaction (August 2018) as reference example.

 - Sales of alloy round bar to Donhad and other customers (note: sales include all alloy round bar whether produced through Liberty OneSteel facilities or produced from Liberty OneSteel billet toll-rolled by Moly-Cop)
