KINGDOM OF THAILAND (THAILAND)**

Note for File

The Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) advises that the public notice *'Certain Hollow Structural Sections - Exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand - Preliminary Affirmative Determination - Public notice under section 269TD'*, relating to the above investigation into HSS published in *The Australian* newspaper on 6 June 2012, contained an error.

This notice was published following the Chief Executive Officer's preliminary affirmative determination (PAD) that there appeared to be sufficient grounds for the publication of a countervailing duty notice.

Customs and Border Protection highlights that the subsidy margin table published in *The Australian* as part of this notice included, Zhejiang Yueling Co. Ltd, as a selected cooperating exporter for which an individual subsidy margin had been calculated. The inclusion of this company was made in error, Zhejiang Yueling Co. Ltd., is not a selected cooperating exporter in the investigation into HSS.

The correct subsidy margin table is included below.
