Ministerial Exemption Instrument No. 1 of 2019

Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

I, KAREN ANDREWS, the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered and accepted the recommendations of the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, the reasons for the recommendations, the material findings of fact on which the recommendations are based and the evidence relied on to support those findings in Final Report No. 441 concerning certain steel pallet racking exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China and Malaysia.

Under subsection 8(7)(a) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975, I hereby exempt all components or parts of steel pallet racking, other than beams, uprights and braces from interim dumping duty and dumping duty, as I am satisfied that other like or directly competitive components of steel pallet racking are not offered for sale in Australia by the Australian industry to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade.

This instrument has effect from 19 June 2018. This instrument is subject to judicial review and may be revoked.
