RE: Dumping and Subsidy Investigation – Exports of Certain Railway Wheels from the People's Republic of China – Submission by Masteel in response to Comsteel Submissions

As you know, I act for Maanshan Iron & Steel Co. Ltd and Taiyuan Heavy Industry Railway Transit Equipment Co., Ltd. (**Masteel**) in relation to this investigation.

The Applicant, Comsteel, has made several submissions in relation to this investigation, the most recent being on 16 August 2018.

I do not propose to comment on Comsteel's most recent submission in any detail. There seems no point in exchanging submissions challenging each other's submissions.

However, I make this observation. In its submissions, Comsteel does not seem to comprehend that issues it has with its customers in the products it supplies to those customers will not be remedied by the imposition of antidumping measures and nor is this a matter for the Anti-Dumping Commission.

It is a matter for the parties to resolve between themselves, if possible, in accordance with usual commercial practice. Nothing to do with dumping or subsidies and not something that the Anti-Dumping Commission could remedy by imposing antidumping measures. It is not a dumping or subsidy issue.
