Australia Pacific Electric Cables (APEC) appreciates the opportunity to respond and submits as follows:

It is confirmed that Australia Pacific Electric Cables (APEC) manufactures and sells PVC flat electrical cables in Australia.

APEC have previously suffered losses attributed to dumped and subsidised goods; and as such have an interest in the matters referred to in Report 469; and in any subsequent developments.

Chapter 10 of Anti-Dumping Investigation Report 469 considers questions of "Will Dumping and Material Injury Continue?" .

APEC concurs with the comments in 10.1 Finding.

In our view, and in the absence of any remedy, measures taken on Dumping duties imposed on PVC flat cables exports from China to Australia **should continue** to be levied.

Any **reversal** of decisions on Report 469 will cause material injury to APEC.
