MEETING WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM
THE CHINA CHAMBER OF INTERNATIONAL COMMERCE**

10 DECEMBER 2018

Representatives from the China Chamber of International Commerce (CCOIC) and representatives from an explosives manufacturer met with the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commission) to discuss the ongoing investigation into alleged dumping of ammonium nitrate in so far as it relates to the goods exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China).

The following matters were discussed at the meeting:

- the role of the CCOIC and its interest in this investigation;
- the preliminary dumping margin determined for exporters from China;
- the circumstances in relation to the goods imported from China and the entities that import the goods from China; and
- the applicants' injury allegations in so far as they relate to exports of the goods from China.

The CCOIC indicated that it will outline its concerns and the matters discussed at this meeting in a written submission to the Commission, and provide a non-confidential version suitable for the public record.
