## AMMONIUM NITRATE – REINVESTIGATION

### ANTI-DUMPING REVIEW NO. 107

### EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, SWEDEN AND THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

#### NOTE FOR FILE

On 19 November 2019, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel), pursuant to section 269ZZL(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*, requested that the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) reinvestigate certain findings made in the investigation into alleged dumping of ammonium nitrate exported from the People's Republic of China, Sweden and the Kingdom of Thailand.

The reinvestigation report is due on 17 February 2020. Following the Commissioner's request for a longer period to provide his reinvestigation report, the Review Panel granted the Commissioner an extension of time to provide the reinvestigation report. The reinvestigation report is now due by **3 April 2020**.

The Commission will publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and will invite interested parties to make submissions before submitting the reinvestigation report to the Review Panel.

In preparing the reports, the Commission will take into account all relevant information, including the Australian industry applicants' updated financial data for the period 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2019, and any submissions made in response to the preliminary reinvestigation report.
