Exported from The People's Republic of China

Exporter questionnaires received – October 2018

Responses received

On 29 August 2018, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice advising on the responses to the full exporter questionnaire, received by the due date of 20 August 2018.¹ The following entities have now provided a full exporter questionnaire response, by the due date or the date provided for in an extension of time granted by the Anti-Dumping Commissioner (the Commissioner)²:

For the exporters selected in the sample for this review, the non-confidential version of the full exporter questionnaire responses have been placed on the public record.

However, it should be noted that the Commission will not have assessed these responses for deficiencies at the time of publication. Additionally, providing a response to the full exporter questionnaire, for non-selected exporters, does not guarantee an exporter will have its information individually examined and/or an individual rate of duty determined.

Extensions of time

The Commission has not received any further requests for extensions of time to submit an exporter questionnaire response.

Verification of responses to the exporter questionnaire

The Commission will seek to verify the financial data provided by selected exporters in the responses to the exporter questionnaires and has invited members of the Australian industry to a pre-verification meeting.

Any oral information given to the Commission in a pre-verification meeting will not be taken into account unless it is subsequently put in writing and made available as part of the public record.³

In addition, any information provided to the Commission in a pre-verification meeting may be disregarded unless a non-confidential summary containing sufficient detail to allow a reasonable understanding of the substance of the information for inclusion in the public record.⁴

Uncooperative and non-cooperative exporters

Where an exporter provides a response to the exporter questionnaire that contains deficiencies that could not be rectified quickly and easily in a further response, the exporter may be deemed uncooperative and/or non-cooperative.

Exporters that do not provide a response to the exporter questionnaire by the due date must be deemed uncooperative and/or non-cooperative.

Residual exporters

The Commission received voluntary responses to the full exporter questionnaire by the due date, or a later date as granted by the Commissioner, from four non-selected entities as listed in table above.

The Commission received responses to the residual exporter questionnaire by the due date from the following non-selected entities⁵:

Verification of responses to the exporter questionnaire

The Commission will seek to verify the financial data provided by non-selected exporters after assessing whether extending the review to these exporters is likely to prevent the timely completion of the review. In assessing this, the Commission will consider the level of cooperation from the selected exporters, the number of exporters seeking individual examination and the available resources within the Commission to undertake on-site or remote verification. The Commission has not invited members of the Australian industry to a pre-verification meeting at this time.
