Investigation No. 482 – Aluminium extrusions exported from P R China – Austar Holdings International Pty Ltd

Capral Limited (“Capral”) notes that in the current review of measures Investigation No. 482 for aluminium extrusions exported from the People’s Republic of China (“China”) that there does not appear to be any participation by Austar Holdings International Pty Ltd (“Austar”) and its trading companies StarAlum and StarBuild.


It is Capral’s understanding that Austar and its trading companies StarAlum and StarBuild are significant importers of aluminium extrusions from China, with different trading partners (i.e. exporters) supplying aluminium extrusions for import into Australia.

There is no indication from documents placed on the electronic public record (“EPR”) that Austar or its affiliated companies is cooperating with the Commission in this current review investigation. As a major importer of the goods the subject of this review investigation, and a supplier of goods at [*pricing relative to Australian industry supply*] Capral encourages the Commission to approach Austar to verify information related to its purchases of imported aluminium extrusions from Chinese suppliers.
