Response to Moulis Legal letter on behalf of TSP re SEF487

Thank you for your email dated 21 February.

As you are aware, Spring Street Advisory acts for Keppel Prince Engineering Pty Ltd (**KPE**) as representative in relation to the continuation action referred to above.

I have now discussed the recent correspondence from Shanghai Taisheng Wind Power Equipment Co., Ltd's (**TSP**) representatives with my client KPE and we do not support what TSP is seeking in relation to dumping duties on steel wind towers imported from China and Korea.

In KPE's view there should be no exemption for any dumped steel wind towers from China or Korea, nor should there be any derogation that could allow dumped steel wind towers from China or Korea to arrive here without the appropriate duty being paid.

The [**CONFIDENTIAL TEXT DELETED – commercial relationship**] is not relevant to SEF487 and should not influence or in any way bear upon the findings in SEF487 and any recommendations of the Anti-Dumping Commission in relation to the continuation of the dumping measures against Chinese or Korean exporters.
