



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2019/31

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

Prepared or preserved tomatoes

Exported from the Republic of Italy

**Findings of a Continuation Inquiry into
Anti-Dumping Measures**

Public Notice under subsection 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*¹

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has completed an inquiry, which commenced on 16 July 2018, into whether the continuation of the anti-dumping measures in the form of a dumping duty notice applying to certain prepared or preserved tomatoes exported to Australia from the Republic of Italy (Italy) is justified. Exports from Italy by Feger di Gerardo Ferraioli S.p.A and La Doria S.p.A are not covered by that inquiry, as the relevant dumping duty notice does not apply to those company's exports of the goods.

Recommendations resulting from the inquiry completed by the Commissioner, reasons for the recommendations, and material findings of fact and law in relation to the inquiry are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 488* (REP 488).

I, KAREN ANDREWS, the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology, have considered REP 488 and have decided to accept the recommendation and reasons for the recommendation, including all the material findings of facts and law therein, and, pursuant to subsection 269ZHG(1)(a) of the Act, I have **decided not** to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures currently applying to prepared or preserved tomatoes exported to Australia from Italy. The measures will expire on 16 April 2019.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (www.adreviewpanel.gov.au), in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
