AUSTRALIAN INDUSTRY RESPONSE TO ADN NO. 2019/28

Liberty Steel refers to the recently published *Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts and the Final Report* decision of the Commission.¹

Liberty Steel observes that the SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 18 April 2019, that is the day before the commencement of the Easter/Anzac day holiday period in Australia.

As key staff responsible for reviewing and responding to the SEF are required to take leave across this period, an extension to the time for making any submissions in response to the SEF is requested. **Specifically, an additional seven (7) days to make submissions in response to the SEF under s.269TEA(3)(a)(iv) is sought.**
