## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2019/143**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

### **Certain Aluminum Extrusions**

**Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China**

**Findings in Relation to a Review of Anti-Dumping Measures  
Relating to Guangdong Huachang Aluminium Factory Co., Ltd  
(Review No. 497)**

***Notice under section 269ZDB(1)(a)(i) of the Customs Act 1901***

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review, which commenced on 15 January 2019, of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain aluminium extrusions (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China) by Guangdong Huachang Aluminium Factory Co., Ltd (Huachang). The anti-dumping measures are in the form of a dumping duty notice and a countervailing duty notice.

Recommendations resulting from the review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 497* (REP 497).

I, Karen Andrews, the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered REP 497 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 497.

Under section 269ZDB(1)(a)(i) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act), the dumping duty notice and countervailing duty notice applying to the goods exported to Australia from China by Huachang is to remain unaltered.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel ([www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au)) in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.


