ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2019/38

Grinding Balls

Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Findings in Relation to an Accelerated Review of Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Measures

Notice under subsection 269ZG(3) of the Customs Act 1901

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed an accelerated review, which commenced on 2 January 2019, of the anti-dumping measures applying to Grinding Balls (the goods) exported to Australia by Growth Steel Grinding Balls (Suzhou) Co Ltd (Growth Steel) from the People's Republic of China.

Recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 502* (REP 502).

I, Karen Andrews, the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered REP 502 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts and law set out in REP 502.

Under subsection 269ZG(3) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975*, that the original dumping duty and countervailing duty notices currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from China remain unchanged

Growth Steel may apply again for an accelerated review.
