## REINVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FINDINGS RELATING TO POWER TRANSFORMERS EXPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA AND TAIWAN

### NOTE FOR FILE

On 31 January 2020, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP), pursuant to section 269ZZL(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*, requested that the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) reinvestigate a certain finding made in the continuation inquiry into anti-dumping measures applying to certain power transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan. The ADRP matter is No. 2019/119, and further details regarding the reinvestigation request are available on the ADRP website, [www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au). The Commissioner's reinvestigation report is due to be provided to the ADRP by **4 June 2020**.

The Anti-Dumping Commission (Commission) invites submissions from interested parties that may be able to provide additional information that would be relevant to the reinvestigation request. Submissions are requested by **3 April 2020**.

The Commission will publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and will invite interested parties to make submissions in response. The Commission will then have regard to these submissions before submitting the final reinvestigation report and the Commissioner's findings to the ADRP by the due date.
