**Exporter questionnaire received and extensions of time  
granted**

Response received

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) received a response to the exporter questionnaire by EverPress Aluminium Industries Sdn Bhd (EverPress) on 4 June 2019. This is after the due date of 3 June 2019.

The non-confidential version of the exporter questionnaire response has been placed on the public record after providing EverPress a reasonable timeframe to rectify deficiencies that could be quickly and easily rectified in a further response.<sup>1</sup>

Extensions of time

The Commission did not receive a request from EverPress for an extension of time to submit an exporter questionnaire.<sup>2</sup>

Uncooperative and non-cooperative exporter

Exporters that do not provide a response to the exporter questionnaire by the due date must be deemed uncooperative and/or non-cooperative. Accordingly, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has determined EverPress to be an uncooperative and non-cooperative exporter for the purposes of review 509.

However, notwithstanding this determination, the Commission will consider EverPress' response to the exporter questionnaire as a late response in accordance with section 7 of the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-Cooperation) Direction 2015*.

## PUBLIC RECORD

### Verification of responses to the exporter questionnaire

The Commission will seek to verify the financial data provided by EverPress in its response to the exporter questionnaire and has invited members of the Australian industry to a pre-verification meeting.

Any oral information given to the Commission in a pre-verification meeting will not be taken into account unless it is subsequently put in writing and made available as part of the public record.<sup>3</sup>

In addition, any information provided to the Commission in a pre-verification meeting may be disregarded unless a non-confidential summary containing sufficient detail to allow a reasonable understanding of the substance of the information for inclusion in the public record.<sup>4</sup>
