HIGH DENSITY POLYETHYLENE EXPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE, THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

NOTE FOR FILE: EXTENSIONS OF TIME FOR QUESTIONNAIRE RESPONSES

13 AUGUST 2019

On 24 June 2019, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified certain exporters of high density polyethylene (HDPE) from the Republic of Korea, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the United States of America, by email, that exporter questionnaire responses in relation to investigation 515 were due no later than 31 July 2019.

On the same day, the Commission notified certain importers of HDPE that importer questionnaire responses in relation to investigation 515 were due according to the below:

- Part A was due no later than 1 July 2019
- Parts B and C were due no later 15 July 2019

The Commission received requests for extensions of time to the due date from certain exporters and importers within the legislated period, who have communicated their intent to cooperate with the investigation. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by the General Manager of the Commission, having regard to the exporters' and importers' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time for the submissions of parts B and C of the importer questionnaire given to individual importers and provides a summary of the revised due dates where applicable.
