Review of Measures 528
Hot rolled coil steel exported to Australia from Taiwan
Extensions of time granted to provide a Questionnaire response

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) initiated a Review of Measures applying to certain hot rolled coil steel (HRC or the goods) exported to Australia from Taiwan. At the time of initiating this review, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified exporters of HRC that complete questionnaire responses were due by 25 November 2019.

Certain exporters who communicated their intent to cooperate with this review and who requested extensions of time to the due date within the legislated period were granted extensions of time to provide an exporter questionnaire response.

Due consideration was given to the extension requests by the General Manager, Investigations, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015* (the Direction).¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time granted in relation to individual exporters and the revised due dates:
