Accelerated Review Investigation No. 534 – Application by Premium Aluminium (M) Sdn Bhd

Capral Limited (“Capral”) notes that Accelerated Review Investigation No. 534 (“Investigation 534”) is the third application by Premium Aluminium (M) Sdn Bhd (“Premium Aluminium”) to seek individual variable factors via an accelerated review¹.

Premium Aluminium’s application for accelerated review is dated the same date as the application the subject of Accelerated Review Investigation No. 510 (“Investigation 510”).

In Investigation 510 Capral notified the Anti-Dumping Commission (“the Commission”) that Premium Aluminium’s application did not disclose sufficient information concerning the grounds for the application².

It is further noted that Premium Aluminium has, for the purposes of this most recent application, included a declaration that it did not export aluminium extrusions during the relevant period, and should be considered a “new exporter” for the purposes of the review application. Capral does not oppose the application by Premium Aluminium, however, would highlight with the Commission that the application remains deficient. Specifically, the applicant is required to include in its application a response to the following questions:

“ 8. Provide a statement setting out the basis on which you consider the particular dumping or countervailing notice is inappropriate, so far as the applicant is concerned.”

Premium Aluminium’s application merely states that a new exporter may seek an accelerated review. Premium Aluminium’s application does not address the question as to why the dumping and countervailing duty notices to which exported goods apply are “inappropriate” to Premium Aluminium.


Capral requests the Commission to terminate the accelerated review Investigation 534 as Premium Aluminium has not provided sufficient grounds to warrant the conduct of an accelerated review inquiry.
