**Aluminium micro-extrusions exported to Australia
 from the People's Republic of China
 by
 Guangdong Jiangsheng Aluminium Co Ltd and
 Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Co Ltd**

File Note - Extension of time for exporter questionnaire responses

On 17 February 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified Guangdong Jiangsheng Aluminium Co Ltd and Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Co Ltd, exporters of aluminium micro-extrusions (the goods) to Australia from the People's Republic of China, that questionnaire responses in relation to this investigation were due by no later than 25 March 2020.

The Commission has received requests for extensions of time to the due date from both exporters within the legislated period, who have communicated their intent to cooperate with the investigation. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by a General Manager of the Commission, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to individual exporters and provides a summary of the revised due dates:

Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Co Ltd	30	24 April 2020
