Micro-extrusions exported from China

Dear Director,

The submission is made on behalf of Guangdong Jiangsheng Aluminium (Australia) Pty Ltd (JS Aluminium), in response to the injury assertions made by Alushapes in its dumping application.

Whilst JS Aluminium strongly believes that the submitted information will confirm that its exports of the subject goods were not dumped during the investigation period, it continues to also dispute that its exports caused material injury. Instead, JS Aluminium contends that the injury suffered by Alushapes during the investigation period is self-inflicted, as its extrusions for [REDACTED] [product details].

By way of example, JS Aluminium understands that [REDACTED] [customer] have a distinct preference for JS Aluminium's equivalent products, as they have encountered [REDACTED] [product issues]. By contrast, JS Aluminium can confirm having no issues raised [REDACTED] [product and customer details].

More specifically, it's understood that the issues revolve around [REDACTED] [product details].

It's unclear whether the Commission intends visiting or seeking views of [REDACTED], but JS Aluminium would certainly encourage the Commission to make contact with customers [REDACTED] [customer] to better understand the issues experienced by those customers with Alushapes' products and which have contributed to their decision to source the imported subject goods.

JS Aluminium also looks forward to the opportunity to meet with and discuss further its views on Alushapes injury claims with the Commission, during the course of the inquiry.
