**542- Investigation on aluminium micro-extrusions exported to Australia  
from the People's Republic of China (China)  
by Guangdong Jiangsheng Aluminium Co Ltd  
and Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Co Ltd**

**Telephone Conversation**

This file note summarises a telephone conversation between Mr John O'Connor, consultant for Aluminium Shapemakers Pty Ltd (Alushapes) and Ms Heidi Yang (Anti-Dumping Commission) on 28 July 2020 regarding the investigation status.

Firstly, Mr O'Connor and Ms Yang had a brief conversation regarding the current Covid-19 pandemic and the impacts on the work arrangement for the Commission.

Mr O'Connor then reiterated Alushapes' concern regarding production cost according to its submission in May 2020.<sup>1</sup> Mr O'Connor also suggested the Commission have regard to Alushapes' proposed approaches regarding the production cost and dumping margin calculation.

Ms Yang indicated that the investigation is ongoing, and verification teams have been notified with submissions from Alushapes. Verification reports will be published on EPR as they are completed. Alushapes is welcome to make further submissions regarding the outcomes of the verification of the subject exporters.
