Investigation No. 543 – Continuation of measures on aluminium extrusions exported from The People's Republic of China – Pan Asia Aluminium (China) Limited exporter verification report

I refer to the PanAsia Aluminium (China) Limited ("PanAsia China") exporter verification report recently placed on the public file (EPR Document 049 refers).

Capral Limited ("Capral") welcomes the Anti-Dumping Commission's findings, including:

- export sales to Australia made by PanAsia China to its affiliated trading business OPAL (Macao Commercial Offshore) Ltd ("OPAL") were not at arms-length; and
- domestic sales on the Chinese market to a related company, PanAsia Industrial (Nanyang) Co., Ltd were also found to have been at non arms-length.


These findings are consistent with the outcomes in the Commission's earlier inquiries into exports to Australia by PanAsia China.

It is noted that the PanAsia China exporter verification report does not include any discussion concerning PanAsia claims that a certain volume of its exports to Australia are for goods that are not made in Australia or which it asserts is due to the "limited presses available locally" to produce customer specific aluminium extrusions that are not high-volume product lines.

These matters are not for consideration in the current continuation of measures inquiry.
