File Note - Extension of time for exporter questionnaire responses

On 3 March 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified Daehan Steel Co Ltd, NatSteel Holdings Pte Ltd and Compania Espanola de Laminacion S.L., exporters of steel reinforcing bar (the goods) to Australia, that questionnaire responses in relation to this continuation inquiry were due by no later than 9 April 2020.

The Commission has received requests for extensions of time to the due date from all exporters within the legislated period, who have communicated their intent to cooperate with the continuation inquiry. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by a General Manager of the Commission, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to individual exporters and provides a summary of the revised due dates:
