**ADRP Review No.143 – Precision Pipe and Tube Steel exported from
the People's Republic of China and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Case 550)**

I refer to your letter of 22 December 2021 requesting the reinvestigation of certain findings in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 550*.

In your letter you requested that I report my findings to you by 21 February 2022. I am seeking an extension of 60 days until 22 April 2022 to complete my reinvestigation and report my findings. I seek this extension for the following reasons:

- Due to the Anti-Dumping Commission's (the commission) changing business requirements, further time is required to progress the reinvestigation and for me to report my findings. This includes further time for the commission to consider the comments made in your letter and to complete an assessment of whether Program 20 conferred a countervailable benefit to non-cooperative entities from China.
- I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and invite submissions from interested parties, which will require additional time.
