



**Review of anti-dumping measures applying to
 A4 copy paper exported from
 the Federative Republic of Brazil, the People's Republic of
 China, the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of Thailand**

File note - Extensions of time to provide exporter questionnaire responses

On 16 April 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified exporters of certain A4 copy paper exported to Australia from the Federative Republic of Brazil (Brazil), the People's Republic of China (China), the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia) and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) that questionnaire responses in relation to the review of measures were due by no later than 23 May 2020.

The Commission has received requests for extensions of time to this due date from certain exporters within the legislated period, who have communicated their intent to cooperate with the review. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by the General Manager, Investigations, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to individual exporters and the revised due dates:
