Dear Director,

This submission is made on behalf of Sam Hwan Vina Co Ltd (Sam Hwan) in response to the Anti-Dumping Commission's (the Commission) findings outlined in Statement of Essential Facts Report No. 553 (SEF 553).

It is noted that the Commission has established that Sam Hwan's exports to Australia during the investigation period was negligible. Sam Hwan supports and confirms that the Commission's dumping findings outlined in SEF 553 provide an accurate summary of the verification team's findings following detailed examination of Sam Hwan's financial records.

It is also noted that Sam Hwan's public record version of its exporter verification report has been on the public record for nearly two months prior to the publication of SEF 553, and no submission or information has been presented that would cause the Commission to overturn or reconsider its dumping finding as it relates to Sam Hwan.

On that basis, Sam Hwan requests that the Commissioner terminate the investigation promptly, insofar as it relates to Sam Hwan.
