



Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

Painted Steel Strapping exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Notice pursuant to sections 10(3B) and 10(3D) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975*

I, ANGUS TAYLOR, Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction (the Minister), decided to issue a countervailing duty notice¹ pursuant to sections 269TJ(1) and 269TJ(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) and a dumping duty notice² pursuant to sections 269TG(1) and 269TG(2) of the Act in respect of painted steel strapping (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, except by Qinhuangdao Jiashilun Packaging Materials Co., Ltd (Jiashilun).

I DIRECT, pursuant to section 10(3B) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim countervailing duty (ICD) referred to in section 10(3A) of that Act in respect of the goods exported from China to Australia be ascertained as a proportion of the export price of those particular goods, and, having regard to the desirability of fixing a lesser amount of duty pursuant to section 10(3D) of the Dumping Duty Act, I DIRECT, that the amount of ICD is fixed such that the sum of:

- (i) the export price of goods of that kind, as ascertained, or last ascertained
- (ii) that amount of the ICD as so fixed
- (iii) the amount of interim dumping duty as fixed under section 8 of the Dumping Duty Act

does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained for the purposes of the countervailing duty notice.

This direction does not apply to goods exported by Jiashilun.

This notice applies to the goods and like goods entered for home consumption as per my declaration set out in the countervailing duty notice.
