**Re: Nam Kim's confirmation dispatch on the Statement of Essential Facts No. 558 and 559 issued by the Anti-Dumping Commission dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2021.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

First of all, Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company (Nam Kim) would like to confirm that we have received **the Statement of Essential Facts and Dumping Calculation Spreadsheets of the Anti-Dumping and Subsidisation Investigation of Aluminium-zinc coated steel** (of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimeters i.e. case 558; and of a width less than 600 millimeters i.e. case 559) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea), Taiwan and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam).

After a review on the appendices and statements, we would like to confirm and totally agree with you on your points and conclusions of Case No.558 and Case No. 559, as below:

- The commission has found no evidence that Nam Kim and other exporters in Vietnam received any subsidies. As a result, Nam Kim was not subsidised or subsidised at negligible levels.
- The dumping margin in respect of the goods Nam Kim exported to Australia during the investigation period is negative 9.7% and negative 7.2% on case 558 and case 559 respectively. As a result, Nam Kim was not at dumped prices.

- **The Commission therefore proposes to terminate:**
  - ✓ **the countervailing investigation in relation to all exporters from Vietnam, including Nam Kim.**
  - ✓ **the dumping investigation in relation to Nam Kim, on the basis that Nam Kim's exports of the goods during the investigation period were not at dumped prices.**

We believe that the Statement of Essential Facts on Nam Kim's cases have complied with the WTO's regulations and ensure the fair competition for us.
