In accordance with Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2021/006, a meeting for interested parties was held on 3 February 2021. The abovementioned interested parties and their representatives attended the meeting.

As specified in ADN No. 2021/06 and by the chairperson at the meeting, interested parties following their oral submissions are required to put their submissions in writing to the Commission within seven days of the meeting for inclusion on the public record, in order for their submissions to be considered in the inquiry.¹

Interested parties who wish to provide submissions in response to the written submissions made within seven days of the meeting, are required to provide their responses to these submissions in writing for inclusion on the public record within 14 days of the meeting.

The Commissioner may not be obliged to have regard to submissions received after this time because consideration of those submissions is likely to prevent the timely placement of the Statement of Essential Facts on the public record.²
