



Continuation Inquiry 565
Ammonium Nitrate
Exported from the Russian Federation

On 30 March 2021 staff of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) met with representatives of Orica Australia Pty Ltd (Orica) at the Commission's premises in Spring St, Melbourne.

The meeting was requested by Orica to explain the commercially sensitive details of two supply contracts as set out in Confidential Annexure A to its 25 March 2021 submission in response to the statement of essential facts (document number 39 on [EPR 565](#)).

As stated in the public record version of that submission, Confidential Annexure A concerns Orica's claimed impact of import pricing on certain contracts for supply of ammonium nitrate. Orica explained to the Commission the commercial mechanism for the calculation and adjustment of prices under these contracts and the likely downward impact on Orica's prices that would eventuate if imported ammonium nitrate at dumped prices were permitted to occur. Orica also explained the basis for its calculation of the injurious profit impact claimed in its submission.

Orica also provided the Commission with a copy of confidential information requested by the Commission to interpret the information that was included in Confidential Annexure A of Orica's submission.
