



Review of anti-dumping measures applying to:

**Steel reinforcing bar exported to Australia
from the Republic of Korea, Singapore, Spain (except Nervacero S.A.)
and Taiwan (except Power Steel Co. Ltd)**

File Note - Extension of time for exporter questionnaire responses

On 10 September 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified Daehan Steel Co Ltd, NatSteel Holdings Pte Ltd and Compania Espanola de Laminacion S.L., exporters of steel reinforcing bar (the goods) to Australia, that questionnaire responses in relation to Review 566 were due by no later than 19 October 2020.

The Commission subsequently received, within the legislated period, requests for an extension to the due date from all of the exporters that had communicated an intent to cooperate with the review. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by a General Manager of the Commission, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to individual exporters and provides a summary of the revised due dates:

Exporter	Revised due date
Compania Espanola de Laminacion S.L.	16 November 2020
Daehan Steel Co Ltd	16 November 2020
NatSteel Holdings Pte Ltd	23 November 2020

On 6 November 2020 the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology determined that after 19 November 2020 the anti-dumping measures would cease to apply in relation to exporters of steel reinforcing bar from Singapore and Taiwan (except Power Steel Co. Ltd).² As a result the Commissioner is no longer examining exporters of the goods from Singapore and Taiwan (except Power Steel Co. Ltd) and no longer requires participation from exporters from these countries for the purposes of Review 566.

¹ From 19 December 2016 the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission delegated his powers to consider and decide requests for an extension of time. This delegation was made under Delegation Instrument No. 2 of 2016.
