



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2021/150

Steel reinforcing bars

**Exported from the Republic of Korea and Spain (except
Nervacero SA)**

**Findings in Relation to
Review of Anti-Dumping Measures No. 566**

***Notice under section 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901 and
section 8(5) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975***

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review, which commenced on 10 September 2020, of the anti-dumping measures applying to steel reinforcing bar (the goods) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (ROK) and Spain (except Nervacero SA).

Recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 566 (REP 566)*.

I, ANGUS TAYLOR, the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction have considered REP 566 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 566.

Under section 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act), that, with effect from the date of publication of this notice the dumping duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from the ROK and Spain (except Nervacero SA) is to be taken to have effect as if different variable factors had been fixed in respect of exporters generally, relevant to the determination of duty.

I determine in accordance with section 8(5) of the Dumping Duty Act, that the interim dumping duty payable in respect of rebar exported to Australia from the ROK and Spain (except Nervacero SA) is an amount which will be worked out in accordance with the combination of fixed and variable duty method pursuant to sections 5(2) and 5(3) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Regulation 2013*.

Particulars of the dumping margins established for each of the exporters and the effective rates of duty are set out in Table 1 of this notice.

| | Uncooperative and all other exporters (except Nervacero SA) | 11.8 | 11.8 | Combination of fixed and variable duty method |

Table 1: Summary of dumping margins, effective rates of duty and duty method

The actual duty liability may be higher than the effective rate of duty due to a number of factors. 
