



Review of anti-dumping measures applying to hollow structural sections exported from the Republic of Korea by HiSteel Co Ltd

File Note - Extensions of time to provide Questionnaire responses

On 1 October 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) initiated a review of measures applying to certain hollow structural sections exported from the Republic of Korea to Australia by HiSteel Co Ltd. Interested parties to the review were notified that questionnaire responses were due by no later than 7 November 2020.¹

The Commission has received requests for extensions of time to this due date from certain interested parties within the legislated period. Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by the General Manager, Investigations, having regard to the interested parties' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.²

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to interested parties and the revised due dates:
